RESOLUTION # 03 - 14

**RE-EMPLOYMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT
GLENN R CANNON**

WHEREAS, Section 3319.01 ORC, requires that a Board of Education in each county, city, and exempted village school district shall, at a regular meeting held not later than the first day of May of the calendar year in which the term of the Superintendent expires, appoint a person possessed of the qualifications provided in this section, to act as Superintendent of the public schools of the district, for a term not longer than five (5) years beginning the first day of August and ending the thirty-first (31st) day of July ; **AND**

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may at any regular meeting held during the calendar year immediately proceeding the year of expiration of the term of employment of a Superintendent of the public schools re-employ such Superintendent for a succeeding term for not longer than five(5) years, beginning on the first (1st) day of August immediately following the expiration of his/her current term of employment and ending on the thirty-first (31st) day of July of the year in which such succeeding term expires; **AND**

WHEREAS, such Superintendent shall be the executive officer of the Board; direct and assign teachers and other employees of the schools under his/her supervision, except as provided in Section 3319.01 of the ORC, assign the pupils of the schools under his/her supervision to the proper schools and grades, provided that the assignment of the pupil to a school outside of his/her district of residence is approved by the Board of the district of residence of such pupil, and perform such other duties as the Board determines; **NOW**

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pioneer Career and Technology Center Board of Education shall approve the re-employment of **GLENN R. CANNON** as Superintendent of the Pioneer Career and Technology Center: A Vocational School District effective August 1, 2014 through July 31, 2017 in accordance with the Board-adopted salary schedule for the Superintendent; all Board-approved fringe benefits; up to \$4,500 travel allowance at the Board-approved rate; Board pick-up of Medicare cost; option for payment upon request of up to ten (10) days unused vacation annually; and, annual membership in the Buckeye Association of School Administrators (BASA), American Association of School Administrators (AASA) and the Shelby Rotary Club
