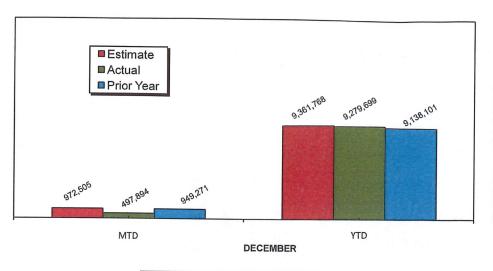

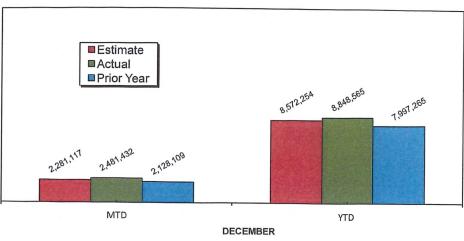

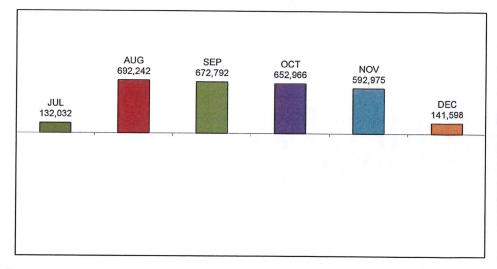
FY 2017/2018 GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURE

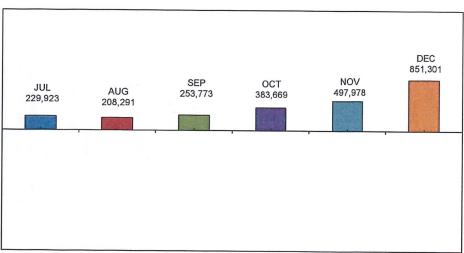




YTD REVENUE VARIANCE ACTUAL YTD VS PRIOR YTD
