The 73rd Annual Ohio FCCLA State Leadership Conference was held at the Ohio Expo on April 25-26, 2019. Hunt, Crestline High School and Pioneer Career and Technology Center Performing Arts senior, sang the national anthem at the opening ceremony of the SLC.
