Any local, city, exempted village or joint vocational school district; community school established under Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3314; STEM school established under ORC 3326; college- preparatory boarding school established under ORC 3328; or chartered nonpublic school MUST notify the Ohio Department of Education no later than July 1 if the school, during the upcoming school year, will begin or cease to use a blended instructional model.<sup>1</sup>

According to Ohio law,<sup>2</sup> "blended learning" means the delivery of instruction in a combination of time in a supervised physical location away from home and online delivery whereby the student has some element of control over time, place, path or pace of learning.
