They competed against nearly 400 SkillsUSA members from 33 schools in the region in 25 Technical Skills Contests. Competing in the Technical Drafting contest Rodney Rike (Jr. Engineering Design Technology, Colonel Crawford High School) earned Bronze; in the Criminal Justice contest: Brent Douglas (Sr. Criminal Justice, Crestview High School) earned Gold; and in the Crime Scene Investigation contest, the team of Amadia Aguirre (Sr. Criminal Justice, Shelby High School), Rehgan Henry (Sr. Criminal Justice, Madison High School) and Summer Kennard (Sr. Criminal Justice, Willard High School) earned Bronze. The winners advance to the 2022 Ohio SkillsUSA Championships that will occur on May 3 and 4, 2022 at the Greater Columbus Convention Center.
