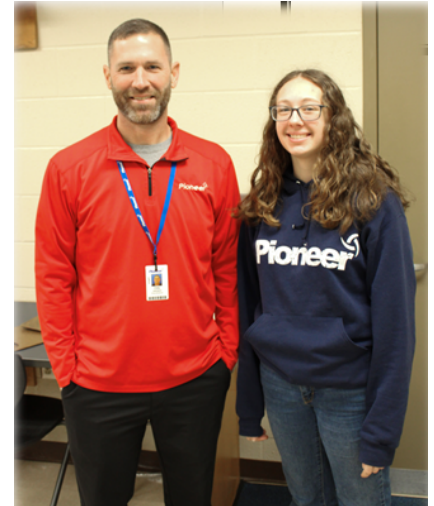


Pioneer Career and Technology Center announces Isabel Alt and Elisha Burson as our January 2023 Student of the Month.
