STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- BPA STUDENTS PLACE AT BPA COMPETITION. 45 students attended the BPA state competition in Columbus last month, and four qualified for National competition. Qualifying for Nationals in Florida in May were Jessica Lohr, who placed second in Computerized Accounting (Colonel Crawford, Business Management), Stephen Walters, who placed second in Interview Skills (Northmor, IT Support), Lance Reece, who placed fourth in PC Servicing and Trouble-shooting (Ontario, IT Support), Justin Orewiler, who placed fifth in PC Servicing and Trouble-shooting (Ontario, IT Support).
