

Career Awareness Use of Funds Plan

Pioneer's Career Awareness Plan includes:

- 1. Providing career coach(es) for multiple days each week who will, at the discretion of the Partner District:
 - a. Meet with each Senior student to finalize their "E"
 - They will connect students who plan to go directly into the workforce to a job that provides a livable wage *
 - ii. They will refer students who plan to access full-time post-secondary education to their School Counselor and the FAFSA coordinator *
 - iii. They will refer students who plan to enlist in the military to the recruiter of the branch of their choice
 - *Some students will access both activities i and ii because they will work and access post-secondary education concurrently
 - b. Meet with each Junior student to share the "What's Your E?" Program
 - For students who plan to go directly into the workforce, they will facilitate student investigation into local jobs that provides a livable wage*
 - ii. They will refer students who plan to access post-secondary education full-time to their School Counselor and the FAFSA coordinator *
 - iii. They will refer students who plan to enlist in the military to the recruiter of the branch of their choice
 - *Some students will access activities i and ii because they will work and access post-secondary education concurrently
 - c. Meet with each Freshman student to set up and complete a YouScience Account
 - i. Students will use their YouScience account to identify their future career interests
 - ii. Students will use their YouScience account to identify their career aptitudes
 - iii. Students will identify local workforce needs related to their interests and aptitudes



- d. Collaborating with District personnel to coordinate the following activities with high school Sophomores:
 - i. Manufacturing Day Tours
 - ii. Sophomore visits to Pioneer.
- e. Coordinating the following activities with high school Freshmen:
 - i. Tours of the NCSC/OSU-Mansfield Campus
 - ii. Enrollment in the Community Opportunities website.
 - iii. Completion of the interest inventory on the OhioMeansJobs website
- f. Collaborating with District personnel to coordinate the following activities with Eighth grade students:
 - i. Eighth grade tours of Pioneer.
- g. Communicating
- h. Coordinating 3rd Grade "Tabletop" Visits by Pioneer's Career Development Department
- i. Providing additional Career Awareness Opportunities that may include:
 - i. Coordinating annual student field trips to local businesses
 - ii. Coordinating annual WAGE (Workforce Awareness for Graduates and Educators) Teacher Tours
 - iii. Coordinating and/or hosting visits to local Job Fairs
 - iv. Other activities as deemed appropriate by the Partner School and/or Pioneer
