**RESOLUTION # 05 - 13
STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Education may not use tax money to pay claims resulting from injuries to a student on school premises regardless of negligence; **AND**

WHEREAS, arrangements should be made to provide group insurance to students and staff at a low premium rate with participation entirely voluntary; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Guardian Life Insurance Company, Madison, WI represented in Ohio by N. Carol Insurance Agency, Columbus, Ohio, with local agent representation by the Shelby Mutual Insurance Agency, 55 W. Main Street, Shelby, 44875, offers a standard accident plan for all students but with football players attending Pioneer Career and Technology Center securing their accident insurance plan through their parent school program; **NOW**

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pioneer Career and Technology Center be authorized to provide Guarantee Trust Life Insurance Company's student accident insurance coverage; maximum coverage of \$25,000 on a volunteer basis to students, teachers, and all other administrative personnel at the following rates:

Low Option school time coverage - \$39.00
High Option school time coverage - \$78.00
Low Option 24-hour coverage - \$96.00
High Option 24-hour coverage - \$192.00
